MODULE PURPOSE

Corporate Reporting (RCR400)

To provide students with a detailed knowledge and understanding of the principles and procedures of financial accounting in order to apply International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) in the preparation of financial statements

Professional Taxation (RPT400)

To provide students with technical knowledge relating to the discipline of taxation at an advanced level, and to develop pervasive skills such as professional skills, the exercise of professional judgement and ethical behaviour

Audit, Assurance and Governance (ROA400)

To provide students with a detailed knowledge and understanding of the principles and practice of external auditing and corporate governance to enable them to practise as professional accountants.

Strategic Management Accounting and Finance (RKS400)

To provide students with a detailed knowledge and understanding of management accounting and financial management principles and practices within different business contexts, focusing on strategic business analysis and performance measurement, to enable them to practice as professional accountants.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A BCom Accounting for Chartered Accountants (C3) degree or BCom Rationum with "R" modules or equivalent

OR

A BCom General Accounting degree (C2), or BCom Rationum (with "RG" modules) or equivalent, with a weighted average mark of at least 55% across all the major exit level modules¹ of the qualification

OR

A relevant BTech degree with a weighted average mark of at least 60% across all the major exit level modules of the qualification.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Due to restrictions on the maximum number of students that can be accommodated in this programme, selection will be made on the basis of first come first served (provided the admission requirements are satisfied).

REGISTRATION

In order to apply provisionally to register for this programme, you must complete the postgraduate registration form which is obtainable from Admissions. On completion, this form is to be returned to Admissions.

You will only be informed of your provisional acceptance onto this programme once this programme has been registered by SAQA (expected in November 2012).
